SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS



The Beaver County Foundation administers many different funds for the benefit of the residents of Beaver County pursuing education in a post-secondary setting. Each scholarship fund has its own selection criteria to evaluate and determine scholarship awards.

Ambridge High School 50s Alumni Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted or enrolled at an accredited college or school.

Eligibility: Ambridge School District

Award: Generally, twelve to fifteen in amounts of \$1,000 to \$2,000 each.

Note: This scholarship is chosen by the 1950s Alumni committee. Applications

submitted to Ambridge Guidance Office.

Ambridge Football Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at an accredited college or school, who was an outstanding football player with high academic achievement and financial need.

Eligibility: Ambridge School District

Award: \$500 to \$1,000

Note: Applications submitted to Ambridge Guidance Office.

Ambridge Polikowski Scholarships

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at an accredited college or school. Must show academic achievement, financial need, and community service.

Eligibility: Ambridge School District **Award:** Five, \$2,000 scholarships

Note: Applications submitted to Ambridge Guidance Office

<u>Frank C. Bauer Leadership Fund</u>

General Qualifications: Graduating seniors of Rochester High School who demonstrated leadership on the football team or any other sport.

Eligibility: Rochester High School

Note: Applications submitted to Rochester High School Guidance Office.

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at an accredited college or university or full-time preparatory program at an accredited performing arts school who participated in his or her high school instrumental music program and will be pursuing a degree in music education.

Eligibility: Any Allegheny, Beaver, or Butler County School District

Award: \$1,000

Note: Must show academic achievement, extra-curricular music ensemble activities, and community service. MUST ALSO INCLUDE UP TO 300 WORD ESSAY IN APPLICATION ON "WHAT MUSIC MEANS TO ME" and a letter of recommendation from their director which speaks to the applicant's ability to successfully complete a four-year undergraduate degree program at an accredited college, university, or conservatory in music education.

<u>Joe Zerilla Scholarship</u>

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted or enrolled at an accredited college or school who participated in sports.

Eligibility: Ambridge School District

Note: Students must complete a separate essay of 150 words or less that explains

why they should receive this scholarship.

Charles Cerjak Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating seniors accepted at a trade or technology school and majoring in a trade or technical field.

Eligibility: Any Beaver County School District

Award: Up to \$2,500

<u>Dylan J. Elchin Scholarship</u>

General Qualifications: Graduates of Beaver County High Schools which have ROTC programs. They must be attending a four year or two-year institution or vocational school or must have signed an obligation to serve in the Armed Services.

Eligibility: Any Beaver County School District with a ROTC program or any student who has or have parents, siblings or grandparents who have honorably served in the Armed Services or who are now currently serving in the Armed Services.

Note: This scholarship also requires two separate essays of less than 250 words each: The first essay should be "Who was Dylan Elchin?". The second essay should

Eligibility: Aliquippa, Beaver Area, Beaver Falls Area, Central Valley, Freedom Area,

Rochester Area, Beaver County Christian, PA Cyber School.

Award: At least one in the amount of \$2,000

Note: There is a separate scholarship application for this award.

<u>John James Manjerovic Memorial Scholarship</u>

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at an accredited college or

university.

Eligibility: South Side School District

Award: Up to \$2,000

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at a select accredited college or university who plans to study conducting education or music performance. The student must be attending one of the following colleges or universities: Geneva College, Grove City College, Westminster College, Duquesne University or Carnegie Mellon University

Award: \$500 to \$1,000

Note: These scholarships are made through the attending college or university.

Fred G. Latherow Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at an accredited college or

university.

Eligibility: Western Beaver School District

Award: \$750

Note: Applications to be submitted to Western Beaver Guidance Office.

Nahas Family Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating senior with preference to a major in Business.

Eligibility: Beaver Area School District

Award: \$500

David B. Otto Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating high school senior planning to attend Penn

State Beaver

Eligibility: Any Beaver County School District

Award: \$500

Malesh - Vageonis Nursing Scholarship

General Qualifications: Graduating senior who plans on entering the nursing profession.

Eligibility: Any Beaver County School District graduating senior with preference

given to Aliquippa, Hopewell or Central Valley School Districts.

General Qualifications: Graduating senior accepted at an accredited college or university with good academic standing, community service and financial need. Application must include a minimum 300-word essay about life in Midland. **Eligibility:** Midland Borough School District and/or any district in which eligible students are enrolled.

Primary Eligibility: Students residing in the Borough of Midland. **Secondary Eligibility:** Students whose parents, grandparents, or great grandparents graduated from the former Midland Lincoln High School.

Award: \$1,000

Charles A. Sciulli Scholarship

General Qualifications: Currently enrolled students in a Beaver County Catholic High School or a Beaver County resident currently enrolled in a Catholic High School or graduated from a Catholic High School in a neighboring county with good academic standing to help pay for Catholic high school or Catholic college or university tuition.

Cory A. Miller Scholarship

General Qualifications: Resident of Midland who either graduated or obtained their GED and is attending a vocational education, technical school, or career education program.

Eligibility: Must be a Midland resident Award: One in the amount of \$1,000

Note: THERE IS A SEPARATE ESSAY WITH THIS APPLICATION. The essay for the scholarship is a one-page essay on their reason for pursuing their plans for the future and discuss one individual who was fundamental in their life in helping them pursue this career.
